

Palmer, Jr. of Workers' Compensation Litigation in West Virginia: Assessing the Impact of the Rule of Liberality and the Need for Fiscal Reform.

Franklin D. Cleckley is the Arthur B. Hodges Professor of Law at West Virginia University College of Law, where his courses include Criminal Procedure, Evidence and Civil Rights. Professor Cleckley has been on the Faculty of West Virginia University College of Law since 1969. He was a Drafter of the West Virginia Rules of Evidence and the West Virginia Rules of Criminal Procedure and Drafter of the 1984 Revisions of the Local Rules U.S. District Court for the Northern District of West Virginia. Professor Cleckley has been a Visiting Professor at: University of Maryland, Mercer University, Louisiana State University, College of William and Mary and Syracuse University. He was also Distinguished Visiting Professor at the University of Mississippi. He is former Associate Justice, West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals and Special Assistant to the General Counsel of Tennessee Valley Authority. Professor Cleckley's publications include: Evidence Handbook for West Virginia Lawyers, Michie, (3 editions - 1978, 1986, 1994); West Virginia Criminal Procedure Handbook, Michie (2 editions - 1984, 1993).

Louis J. Palmer, Jr. has been a staff attorney on the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals since 1996.
